BPS DENTURES (PREMIUM FULL DENTURES)

WHAT IT IS

High-quality, natural-looking false teeth that replace **all** teeth in the upper **or** lower jaw.

WHEN IT'S USED

When all teeth in one or both jaws are missing, or when dental implants aren't suitable - the best alternative if implants aren't possible.

BENEFITS TO YOU

Comfortable fit; helps chewing, speech, and confidence.

LASER GUM TREATMENT (NON-SURGICAL)

WHAT IT IS

A deep clean using a gentle dental laser to reduce bacteria and help gums heal.

WHEN IT'S USED

- If your gum disease is not under control.
- If earlier gum treatment hasn't worked well enough.

YOUR ASSESSMENT INCLUDES

- A clear written report for you and your dentist
- Full gum check (measuring deep spaces; looking for signs like bleeding or soreness)
- An initial clean if there's heavy tartar
- Personal home-care coaching
- · GP referral if blood tests are needed

WHY LASER

Helps reduce bacteria and supports healing, often with improved comfort.

FEES

- Active treatment £955

REDUCING DEEP GUM SPACES (SURGICAL)

WHAT IT IS

Gently reducing deep spaces between teeth and gums so they're easier to keep clean.

WHEN IT'S USED

When deep spaces remain after standard gum treatment.

BENEFITS TO YOU

Easier day-to-day cleaning; supports long-term gum and tooth health.

FEES

- Assessment £85
- Surgery from £300
- Review £85

REBUILDING BONE SUPPORT AROUND A TOOTH

WHAT IT IS

Rebuilding some of the **bone that holds a tooth in place** when that support has thinned because of gum problems.

WHEN IT'S USED

When the bone holding a tooth has thinned but the tooth still has a good chance of being kept.

BENEFITS TO YOU

Stronger support for the tooth; helps reduce looseness and the risk of the gums receding further.

FEES

- Assessment and scan £85

SAVING PART OF A BACK TOOTH (HEMISECTION)

WHAT IT IS

Removing the damaged half of a back tooth and keeping the healthy half.

WHEN IT'S USED

When one half can't be repaired but the other half can support a crown.

BENEFITS TO YOU

Keeps part of your own tooth; cheaper than replacing the whole tooth.

FEES

• Hemisection - £275

Restorations like a crown are priced by your own dentist, or can be done alongside hemisection with us.



CROWN LENGTHENING (FUNCTIONAL)

WHAT IT IS

Moving the gum (and sometimes a small amount of bone) to show more of a broken/decayed tooth so it can be repaired properly.

WHEN IT'S USED

If a tooth has broken under the gum line and your own dentist says it can't be fixed, this advanced technique can sometimes save it.

BENEFITS TO YOU

Can save the tooth and avoid extraction; often lower cost than replacing a missing tooth.

FEES

From £400

CROWN LENGTHENING (COSMETIC)

WHAT IT IS

Reshaping the gums to **show more tooth** and even out the gum line.

WHO IT HELPS

- "Gummy" smiles (too much gum on show)
- Uneven gum lines
- · Short-looking teeth where healthy tooth is hidden under the gum

WHAT TO EXPECT

- Careful planning with photos and measurements to preview the likely result
- A natural-looking, more even smile while keeping treatment conservative

BENEFITS TO YOU

Balances tooth-to-gum proportions; improves smile symmetry and confidence.

FEES

• From £150 (depends on case complexity)



GUM OVERGROWTH REDUCTION

WHAT IT IS

Removing extra gum tissue (sometimes caused by medicines or irritation).

WHEN IT'S USED

When enlarged gums trap plaque or make teeth hard to clean/restore.

BENEFITS TO YOU

Easier cleaning; improved comfort and gum health.

FEES

- Assessment £85
- Treatment varies by case



COVERING EXPOSED ROOTS (GUM GRAFT)

WHAT IT IS

Adding a small piece of soft tissue to cover exposed root where the gum has pulled back.

WHEN IT'S USED

One or two teeth with gum recession, with otherwise healthy gums.

BENEFITS TO YOU

Less sensitivity; protects the root from decay; can improve appearance.

FEES

- Assessment £85
- Graft from £500
- Review Free Total: from £585



FRENECTOMY (LIP TIE)

WHAT IT IS

Trimming or releasing a small fold of tissue (the frenum) in the upper lip that may pull on the gums or create a gap.

WHEN IT'S USED

A high lip frenum causing gum pull/recession or a space between teeth.

BENEFITS TO YOU

Easier cleaning; can help prevent further gum pull or spacing.

FEES

- Assessment (if needed) £85
- Laser treatment £200
- Review Free
